

Field House



Because of the continued generosity of so many who support this project; the Restore the Glory campaign is moving into the planning stage. So many things have been accomplished for the Field House project:

- We are so proud to announce the formation of a Adhoc Board to support the Restore the Glory Committee as we move forward with planning for breaking ground on this project. Welcome! Campaign Co-Chairs: Tom Pogge H66 and Curt Simon H71. Restore the Glory Board (Adhoc): Michael Davlin G69, Timothy Davlin G71, Gene Dunn, Dr. Christopher Huerter, Bill & Mary Moeschler, Dr. Bob Muelleman H75, Arthur L. Peter, Christopher Rodgers, John G74 & Teresa Ryan, Dr. John Wingender H68.
- A Design Charette was held in late February allowing the project to finalize the goals for construction plans.
- An updated cost analysis has been prepared and reaffirms our commitment to this project as the costs are in line with the campaign goal.
- The roof has been replaced. The windows have been removed and the areas around the windows and along the roof line have been

repaired and prepped for future work. The windows have been covered with blue panels and gold letters representing the school colors and spelling out Holy Name Restore the Glory.

- A Site Survey has been completed which has guided the first steps of the work.
- Building on past electrical studies a new Electrical Design proposal has been accepted and will provide the design for separating the electrical services between the school building and the field house.
- A grant application for \$900,000 has been submitted to the State of Nebraska for funding through the ARPA/CARES Act. We need your prayers for a successful outcome!
