

This means that architect, engineering and construction contracts are being finalized. The area around the field house will be fenced off to begin construction when school closes for the holidays.


Our work for the field house campaign continues as we move forward to the final goal of \$5,000,000. The second half of the campaign comprises \$2,400,000. This includes \$770,000 to finalize construction with site prep and contingency, \$1,000,000 for the Invested Reserve Fund to cover maintenance and staffing for the renovated building, and \$630,000 for equipment and programming needs for the sports complex and community space including the current year-round Extended Learning (Afterschool) Program.

Hope at Holy Name School!

Holy Name School began a partnership with the Hope Center for Kids in 2018. This partnership created a pilot after school program for 30-35 students. The programming focused on the necessary structure and support needed during out of school time hours. The pilot program is growing! These children need the added space provided by the renovation of the Field House. Once renovations are complete expanded programming will be available to serve as many as 250 youth from this community in North Omaha.


